





**Driving:** Sat Nav use Hart Leisure Centre. Approx 10 mins from Junc; on 4a M3




**Train:** Fleet Train Station is on the mainline between Southampton and London Waterloo. Taxis are available at the station.





#### Accommodation & Restaurants:

For those requiring accommoda; on, there is a Premier Inn and Holiday Inn Express in the Town Centre. Fleet High Street also has a wide range of restaurants, bars, fast-food and supermarkets for those looking to grab lunch beforehand or a late dinner and is just minutes from the leisure centre.



# Parking

There is a lot of parking at Hart Leisure Centre, but it is a popular centre. Any person parking for more than three hours must register their vehicle on the touch pad screens at reception (free of charge) to avoid parking Tickets (£100). Please remember! We will try to get the system shut off for the day, but please assume it is working unless told otherwise.

#### Sign In

We will be operating a 'Sign-In' system. All swimmers MUST sign-in prior to the start of warm-up of <u>each</u> session to signify that they are present and intend to swim entered events. Sign In sheets will be through the entrance of the changing rooms.

Heat Sheets & Results will be posted at the meet (most likely Changing Area and Spectator Gallery) and will be available via Meet Mobile. All times recorded will be sent to the Swim England Rankings Department within 5 working days of the completion of the competition.

# **Relay Teams**

Electronic relay entries maybe amended up until start of warm-up on the 7th of June should there be a change in swimmer. To edit an entry, click on the 'Edit Submission' link in the confirmation



email received after submitting your relay entry. There is no paper 'Declaration of Swimmers' required on the day of the event. Please amend the electronic entry for the team if there is a change in swimmer and resubmit as soon as possible and latest before warm-up so the appropriate age groups and swimmers are logged for the final heats.

#### **Medals and Prizes**

A medal table will be available poolside to collect your medals and prizes from Hot Heats, sponsored **by Cardinal Performance Swimming!** Please be patient when collecting your medals

Make sure to take your picture on our medal podium out in reception!

Medals will be awarded to the top 3 swimmers in each age group as well as the top 3 relay teams in each age category.

Cardinal will be offering 30 x Hot Heat Prizes of 3 months free dryland and gym programming on their app. This will be an op;on of gym-based dryland or home-based mobility; the winner will get to choose! Hot Heats will be announced prior to the start of Heat. Hot Heat winners can collect their prize from the medal table.

Cardinal are also providing 2 special prizes; for best male and female swimmer of the meet!

#### **Changing and Lockers**

Personal possessions and articles should not be left unattended. Lockers are available for the use of swimmers at a cost of £1.00, redeemable at the locker. Please try and use 'drawstring' bags on poolside to save space.

# Seating

Swimmers may sit poolside or in the upstairs Spectator area. Note, there is no direct access to/from the spectator area to poolside. You will have to walk up/down the stairs through the main area within the Leisure Centre. There is a lift available if needed. Please ensure you are dry and wearing appropriate shoes to walk between poolside and the upstairs seating area.

# Food and drink

There are café facilities at Hart Leisure Centre. Food is not permitted poolside. Drinks are allowed poolside though no cans, glass bottles or hot drinks are permitted on poolside. Café is due to close at 6pm on saturday.

#### Long gap between races?

If you don't want to sit around in the pool heat, Hart Leisure Centre is fortunate to be next to Edenbrook Country Park.
